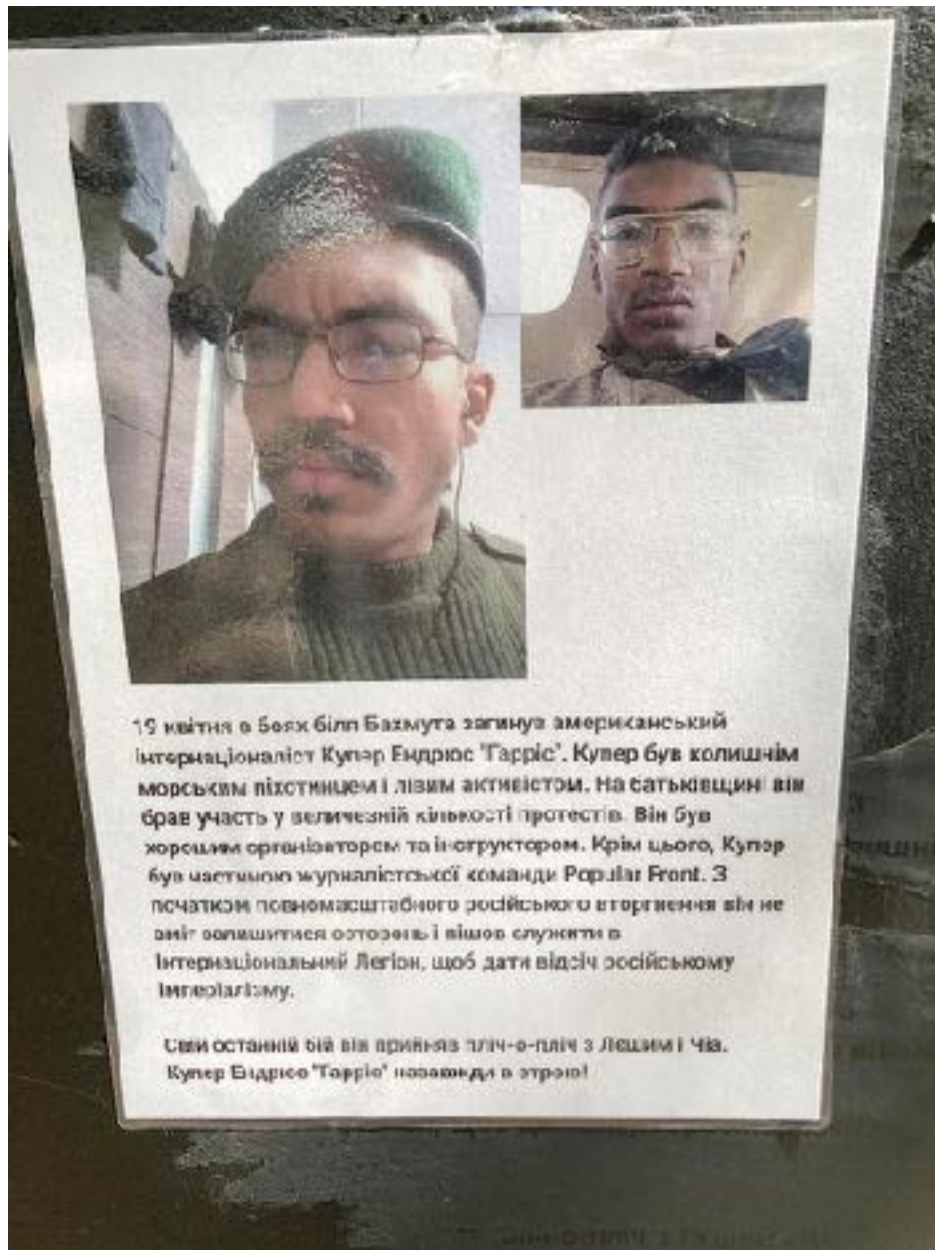

At home, he participated in a huge number of protests. He was a good organizer and instructor. In addition, Cooper was part of the Popular Front journalistic team. 3, at the beginning of a full-scale Russian invasion, he could not stay away and went to serve in the International Legion to repel Russian imperialism.

He took his last fight side by side with Lesh and Chia.
